

NOTICE TO SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PROVIDERS IN THE AVIATION SECTOR TO UNDERTAKE TRAINING FOR PRIVATE AND COMMERCIAL PILOT TRAINING AND HOUR BUILDING FOR PILOTS

Dear Stakeholder

The Transport Education and Training Authority hereby invites accredited skills development providers in the aviation sector to submit a proposal for training between 24 and 72 learners training towards a private pilot license (PPL), commercial pilot license (PPL-CPL) and 20 pilots who intend to accumulate hours through an hour building programme with effect from **1 October 2026.**

The providers interested in the projects must submit a proposal that demonstrates their training fee structure, project plan, demonstrable record of compliance with requirements of aviation law, demonstrate availability of adequate capacity and infrastructure, capability for learner recruitment, training, assessment, completion and certification, evidence of historical contractual performance for projects of similar nature and magnitude. The providers must also affix a valid and proper accreditation or registration with relevant assurance bodies in the aviation industry.

The proposal must be submitted to PMO@teta.org.za by 20 September 2026.
