NOTICE FOR INDEPENDENT EXPERTS TO SERVE AS MEMBERS OF THE INFORMATION, COMMUNICATION AND TECHNOLOGY COMMITTEE OF THE TRANSPORT EDUCATION AND TRAINING AUTHORITY

The TETA Accounting Authority (AA) resolved to establish ICT Committee in terms of item 8(2) (d) of the TETA Constitution appointable for a period not exceeding five years. The panel must be constituted by two current AA members including three external independent IT experts. The TETA needs to enhance its IT maturity level and ensure integrated and dynamic IT environment. The organisation invites experts with diverse and extensive IT environment in the areas such as

- cybersecurity,
- IT Service management,
- software development and programming,
- data analytics, data management and business intelligence
- and IT governance and compliance.

The panel duties

- The panel will convene at least once quarterly at the instance of the accounting authority at a venue determined by the accounting authority in conformity with institutional procurement process. The panel should provide regular reports and recommendations to the accounting authority;
- The panel will maintain confidentiality regarding sensitive information and decisions deliberated during meetings; and
- The panel of advisors must have at least a bachelor's degree in the areas alluded to above and have the capability to offer independent and expert advice on the IT issues.
